



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
# Independent Living is a movement

- Ed Roberts, the "father" of independent living




# What is the independent living philosophy?

It is the belief that people with disabilities across the lifespan can and do have the right to community living and independence. We believe that all people can live with dignity, make their own choices, and participate fully in society.



## A Program – Centers for Independent Living (CILs)

A center for independent living is just that – a local organization run by people with disabilities for people with disabilities in local communities.

#### Who We Serve

Across the lifespan All types of disabilities

Our information and referral services are free to everyone

Most services are free or at a discounted cost For most services, you do need to have a disability, but there are no minimum qualifications for our services

The consumer is the one in control of how and when they receive services



#### **Five Core Services**

- Information and Referral
- Peer Support
- Individual and Systems Advocacy
- Independent Living Skills Training
- Adult and Youth Transitions



## Additional Local Services

Not all of these services are provided at every CIL

- Personal Attendant Care Services (available through all three centers)
- Equipment Loan Program
- Transportation Card (Magic Valley only)
- Temporary Ramp Rentals
- Assistive Technology Loans
